

Québec – Kahnawà:ke Agreement

Respecting
Occupational
Health and Safety

In accordance with the provisions of the Labour Agreement entered into between the Government of Québec and the Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke, a supplementary occupational health and safety agreement has recently been signed.

The supplementary agreement defines the terms of application of a specific occupational health and safety plan in Kahnawà:ke, namely Mohawk Self Insurance (MSI). The Kahnawà:ke

Labor Office (KLO) and the Commission des normes, de l'équité, de la santé et de la sécurité du travail (CNESST) will oversee implementation of the plan.

Under the plan, the KLO will assume all responsibilities associated with Kahnawà:ke employer assessments and compensation of Kahnawà:ke workers.

YOU ARE A KAHNAWÀ:KE EMPLOYER

Your head office or principal establishment is in the territory of Kahnawà:ke

- You must register with the KLO;
- You must declare the wages of all your workers to the KLO regardless of whether they are domiciled in the territory of Kahnawà:ke or outside of it.

YOU ARE A KAHNAWÀ:KE WORKER

You are domiciled in the territory of Kahnawà:ke

- You are covered by the KLO;
- In the event of an accident, you must provide your address on the reserve and file your claim with the KLO.

YOU ARE A MEDICAL SERVICE OR SUPPLIER SERVING WORKERS

in Kahnawà:ke

You must follow up your case directly with the KLO.



YOU ARE A QUÉBEC EMPLOYER

Your head office or principal establishment is outside the territory of Kahnawà:ke

- You must register with the CNESST;
- You must declare the wages of all your workers to the CNESST, including workers domiciled in the territory of Kahnawà:ke.

YOU ARE A QUÉBEC WORKER

You are domiciled outside the territory of Kahnawà:ke

- You are covered by the CNESST;
- In the event of an accident, you must file your claim with the CNESST.

in Québec, outside the territory of Kahnawà:ke

You must follow up your case directly with the CNESST.
